

B.S.A.R.A invites you to attend the **Annual General Meeting** at the **Cathedral Lodge Hotel** on **Wednesday 19th March 2014** at **7:30 p.m.** This meeting is your opportunity as local residents to catch up and respond to the issues that affect your daily lives locally.

This year we welcome **Cllr Mike Wilcox the Leader of Lichfield District Council**, as our speaker on issues currently affecting the City. He will be supported by **Cllr Ian Pritchard (Deputy Leader and Cabinet member for Economic Growth & Development)** and **Richard King (Strategic Director)**.

We also hope that the Police will be represented along with local City and District Ward Councillors and County Councillors.

Over the last twelve months, BSARA has been very proactive on a number of major issues that affect the City and has responded to public consultations on your behalf including the Local Plan Inquiry and the Boundary Commission review of councillor numbers and ward boundaries.

Away from the consultations, BSARA has dealt with the issues that affect our daily lives-potholes, speeding, parking, street lighting, unsociable behaviour, redevelopment of the Angel Croft Hotel and construction delays to the Outer Friary to name but a few.

Local roads are still seen as a major concern in the area and we hope to concentrate most of our efforts this coming year in seeking improvements. We would like to achieve a 20 mph speed limit at the lower end of Beacon Street by the Cathedral School, to make it safer for pupils and the general public on that narrow section of the road. On-street parking has become a major issue with city workers choosing to use free parking on our streets rather than pay in public car parks. Your views are invited on the council's current parking strategy and whether a residents parking scheme for the area should be reconsidered. The move last year of the Post Office has now questioned the need for a crossing on Wheel Lane.
